March 28-29: Kampala

Youth meetings scheduled from 4 pm – 8 pm on the 28th and 29th. I will teach at a church on Sunday morning, the 29th. Then do a disciple training for a small group of 20 people or less from noon to 2 pm on Sunday.

March 30-April 1: Iganga

A discipleship meeting will be scheduled for one of these days. For the other days we will visit teenagers one-on-one. Those that are having problems with drugs and other things. And then have a youth fellowship.

April 2-3: Bugiri

Discipleship meetings for about 20 people being planned for both days.

April 4: Busia Uganda

Getting to know each other. Investigating a possible location for a training center.

April 5-6: Tororo

April 6- Visit Kimaeti

A social visit with family, whom I love very much.

April 7-9- Eldoret

One all-day youth conference and two all-day discipleship conferences of around 20 people are being planned

April 10-23 Segera Mission (near Nanyuki)

You can read all about it in the blog of my website. I am planning to do Bible classes and discipleship classes every day over the two weeks with the location being at the mission.

April 24-26 Nairobi

Youth conferences being organized. I will teach at his church on Sunday morning.
