The plane tickets have now been purchased for my daughter and I to begin our mission trip together in Rwanda on March 9. After two weeks, my daughter will head back to the USA. Several weeks ago, I received a message on WhatsApp, complete with photos, from Rwanda. Someone has donated just over ¼ acre of land in that country which will be used to build a training center for Bible Application Ministries! Wow!

This is only the beginning. I am convinced God will soon provide the means for us to have training centers set up all over the world so we can effectively train disciples at these locations rather than having to travel all over the country to find them. Hints of this are already coming from Uganda, Kenya, Nepal and Bangladesh.

frequently post 1-minute videos here with updates about the ministry. During my mission trip, I plan to share exciting things every day to keep you informed almost real-time about what God is causing to take place.

I also plan to post frequently to the 'Bible Application Ministries' Facebook page. If you 'like' the Facebook page, you will receive short, live teachings on a weekly basis, along with additional testimonies and frequent updates while I am on the mission field. These weekly live teachings I am categorizing under a theme called "Brighten Your Day" because of their comfort and encouraging nature.

I have teachings currently being translated into the Spanish, Urdu, Swahili and Romanian languages. My vision is that God will rise up volunteers to translate them into many, many other languages as well. Is God tugging on your heart to help with this project?

The next mission trip I am preparing my heart for right now involves Nepal, Sri Lanka and Pakistan. It will be at least a 2-week expedition in that country. It will involve at least 3 different locations, and many tribal areas.

I plan to start a new teaching series once I return from my African mission trip at the end of April.
